Application Process and Requirements:

Please prepare the following documents either in English or in Chinese. The documents will not be returned to you after submission. Please make copies for yourself if needed or apply through the online system.

To obtain an Admission Letter for student visa, it requires **three working days** processing time from the submission day of tuition fees. Please make the payment early.

1. If you do not need student visa, you need to prepare:

- 1) Application form.
- 2) Two passport photos (2 inch by 2 inch)
- 3) One copy of passport.

2. For those who wish to apply for a student visa: You also need to submit the following requirements: If any document is insufficient, MLC will not offer any certification for visa.
 - 4) A copy of the high school/university enrollment certificate, transcript or diploma.
 - 5) An original financial statement issued by your bank with at least US\$2000 valid within 3 months. A letter (original copy signed and endorsed) from a sponsor or guarantor with a bank statement is also acceptable if you don't have a bank account.
3. Transfer students: besides the item 1), 2) and 3), please also provide a transcript from your previous Chinese language center.
